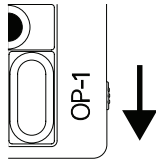


OP-1 quick start guide

1. power up

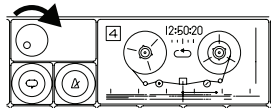
power button

turn on your OP-1 by sliding the power switch located on the short right side of the unit towards you.



volume

turn up the volume by turning the volume knob located on the left side of the screen clockwise.



play on the piano keys.



press the [stop] key to stop recording.



rewind to the starting point by pressing and holding the [rewind] key.



press [play] to listen to your recording.



2. play a synthesizer sound

press the [synthesizer] key.



select a preset sound by pressing any key from [1-8].



press any key on the keyboard.



5. use the mixer

press the [mixer] key.



now press the [play] key to start playing the tape. adjust the individual track levels by turning the related color coded knobs.



3. play a drum sound

press the [drum] key.



select a preset sound by pressing any key from [1-8].



press any key on the keyboard.



press and hold the [shift] key while turning the color coded knobs to adjust the panning for each track.



6. congratulations!

you have now learned the basics of OP-1 operation. there is still much more to explore, so keep playing.
