
quick start guide

1. power up

power button

turn on your OP-1 by sliding the power switch located on the short right side of the unit towards you.



play on the piano keys.




press the [stop] key to stop recording.



volume

turn up the volume by turning the volume knob located on the left side of the screen clockwise.



rewind to the starting point by pressing and holding the [rewind] key.



press [play] to listen to your recording.

5. use the mixer



play a synthesizer sound

press the [synthesizer] key.



select a preset sound by



pressing any key from [1-8].

press any key on the

keyboard.



press the [mixer] key.



now press the [play] key to start playing the tape. adjust the individual track levels by turning the related color coded knobs.



play a drum sound press and hold the [shift] press the [drum] key.

key while turning the color coded knobs to adjust the panning for each track.



select a preset sound by pressing any key from [1-8].







press any key on the keyboard.



6. congratulations!
