teenage engineering at latest SFMOMA exhibition “art of noise”.

SFMOMA’s exhibition “art of noise” is now open, celebrating “pioneering designs shaping our music experiences”.

“art of noise” features a total of 800 artworks made up of “550 posters, 150 album covers, 100 design objects and four large-scale installations that merge inventive design and audio.”

the exhibition is an extensive exploration of design within music. teenage engineering have collaborated with SFMOMA on the overall setting, using their field rail system and color scheme, creating “communal listening spaces and unique sound environments”. this includes an interactive and immersive seating area with embedded custom audio playback devices, as well as a gallery featuring the teenage engineering choir.
