introducing computer-2 the computer case you can't buy.

teenage engineering set a goal to design the cheapest computer case in the world. their engineers worked day and night to really push the limits and they went beyond all expectations. they engineered it all the way down to a cost of 0.

continuing their campaign, “25 the flipped out year”. teenage engineering introduces computer-2. a small form factor, mini-ITX computer case.

constructed from a single sheet of semi-transparent PP-plastic, the chassis features integrated living hinges and snap hooks that make assembly refreshingly tool-free. just fold, snap, and you're nearly there. installing the motherboard is equally effortless — simply push-click it into place with no screws, brackets, or stress required.

designed around the mini-ITX standard, the chassis comfortably houses a compact build without sacrificing performance. it fits a mini-ITX motherboard, an SFX power supply, and a dual-slot graphics card up to 180mm in length – all neatly packed into a small form factor that's easy to carry, simple to service, and satisfyingly minimalist.

whether you're building your first system or just tired of over-complicated cases, this chassis keeps things clean, clever, and almost completely screw-free.
